6. Write it down and save it!

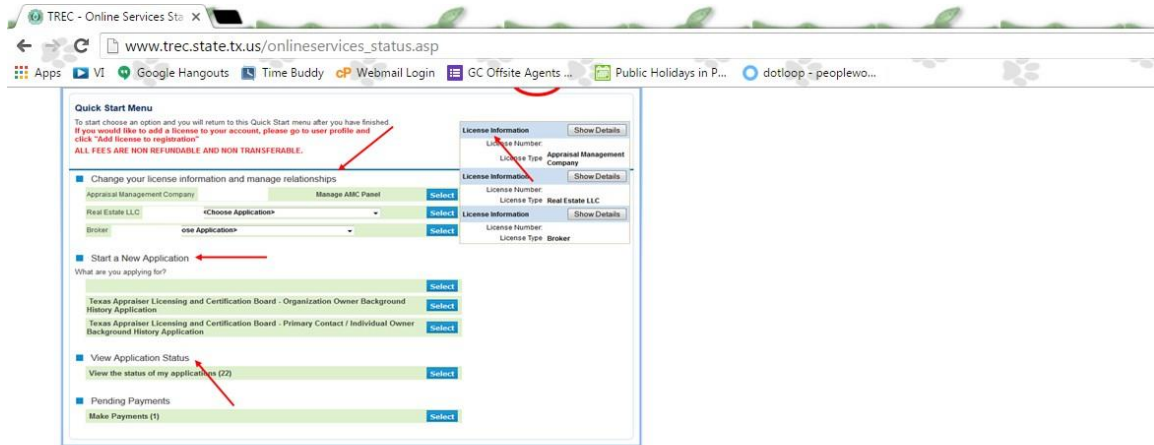
Forgot Your Password?

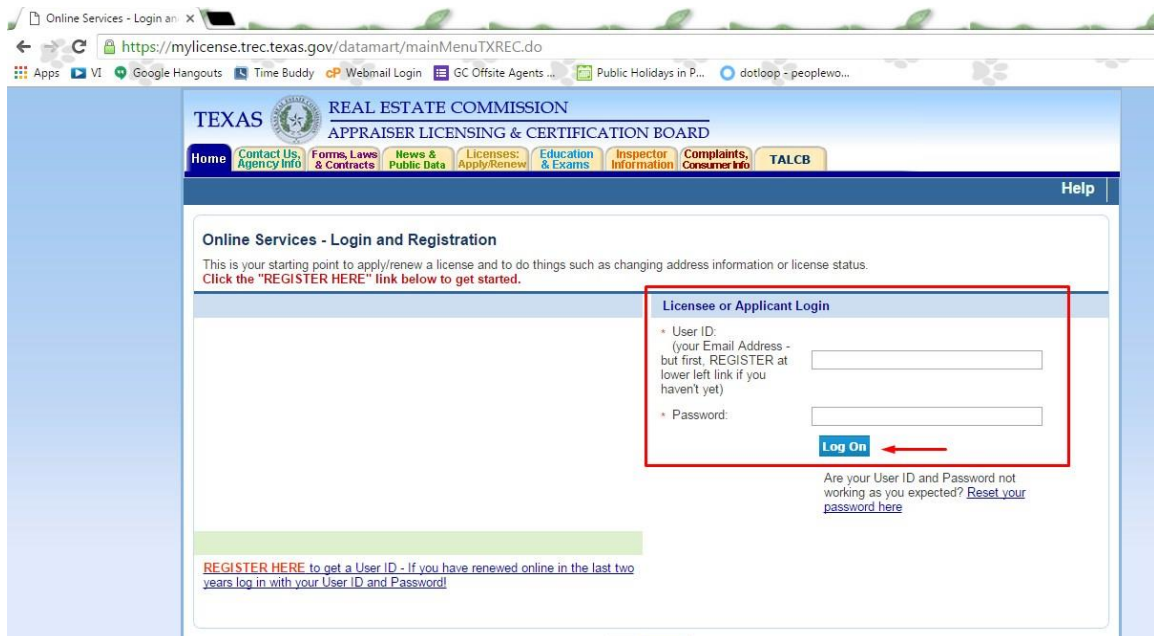
