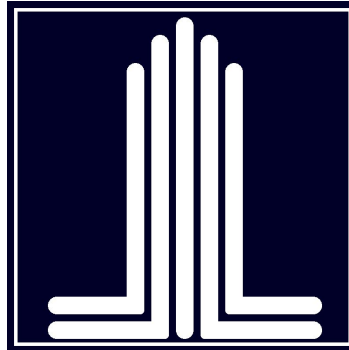

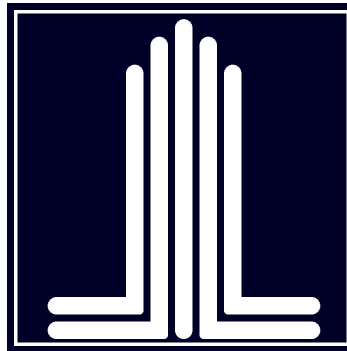

Documents and info for Submission

Please complete your onboarding in BrokerSumo (an invite will be emailed to you). You will be filling out and submitting a Real Estate Independent Contractor Agreement, Credit Card Authorization Form, and W9 form within that tool. You will also be setting up your account, uploading a photo of your driver's license, and inputting your credit card info. If funds are sent to Texas Ally on your behalf, please ensure that your ACH info is inputted so you can be paid by direct deposit. Your change of Broker sponsorship with TREC and MLS Board Transfer must also be completed.

Transaction Management/Checklist

For each Sale or Lease Transaction, please use the below checklists as guides for smooth processing of commissions and recording of closed deals. Please request approval for CDAs **AT LEAST 3 whole business days before** the scheduled close date to ensure it is approved and sent on time.

- TRANSACTION MANAGEMENT in [BrokerSumo](#) (backoffice software tool)
 - MLS Listings will sync (as long as agent name matches exactly (MLS=BrokerSumo)) and auto-populate some fields
 - Fill in remaining needed fields
 - Update Commission Plan if needed based on Lead Origination
 - Internal team will override this if labeled incorrectly
 - Add applicable task list
 - The greyed out tasks require a document to be uploaded to transaction before checking off
 - Add Title Company information
 - Create Disbursement
 - Net Amount Due to Brokerage should have the comment “Mail payment to Texas Ally Real Estate Group at 1301 S Interstate 35, Suite 314 Austin, TX 78741”
 - Net Amount Due to “Agent Name” should have the comment “Cut directly to Agent” if applicable
 - Lease commissions must be mailed to the office
 - Send Email request for approval through BrokerSumo

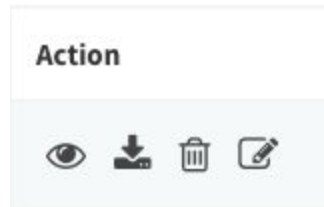
