Digital Millennium Copyright Act Notice

We will respond as promptly as possible to any reports of copyright infringement on our website and in any IDX displays and IDX content. Texas Ally works within the guidelines of the US Digital Millennium Copyright Act ("DMCA") to address and rectify any and all reports and instances of copyright infringement.

Texas Ally reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to block or remove any objectionable content or material. Regardless of whether Texas Ally removes or blocks content or material, Texas Ally will make a good-faith effort to notify you if a copyright infringement complaint is made against you.

Notice of Copyright Infringement

The Notice must be in writing (email or letter) and must contain the following:

- Signature (hand-signed or electronic) of the owner, or a person authorized by the owner, of a copyright that is allegedly infringed.
- Identification of the original copyrighted work that is allegedly infringed, including website address / URL, location on the webpage, type of material (such as whether it is text, a photo,

or both), a description of the work, and any other relevant information, sufficient for Texas Ally to identify it.

- Identification of the material in a Texas Ally website or display that is allegedly infringing upon the work from point ii. above, including website address / URL, location on the webpage, type of material (such as whether it is text, a photo, or both), a description of the work, and any other relevant information, sufficient for Texas Ally to identify it.
- Statement that the complaining Party has a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.
- Contact information for the complaining Party, including email address, mailing address, and phone number.
- Statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that the complaining Party is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.

Texas Ally Procedure

Take-Down Procedure. Upon receipt and verification of notice of infringement, Texas Ally will remove the infringing materials, at its sole discretion. To the extent possible, Texas Ally will notify the infringing party in writing after removal. Advance notice of removal is generally not possible.
